### **How to estimate your FAFSA results**

If you're a college-bound senior, you will soon submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Colleges will use your FAFSA results to determine how much they will award you in financial aid.

To estimate your FAFSA results now, use the [College Funding Estimator](#) <http://educationquest.org/estimator.asp> at **EducationQuest.org**. The program will ask for 2010 income tax information. You may estimate your tax information to complete the Estimator but should use your completed 2010 tax returns when you submit the actual FAFSA. To meet your college's financial aid priority date, complete your taxes early.
